Paul R. Zalucky is an independent consultant at international projects focusing on businesses intelligence, risk management, and international relations.

Mr. Zalucky entered public service and worked for the U.S. Government from 1982 until his retirement in 2007. Overseas, Mr. Zalucky served as the Senior Advisor in two geopolitically key locations: to Amb Pifer and Amb Pascual in Kyiv and Amb Ash in Warsaw. In 2002 he was promoted to the Senior Executive ranks of U.S. Government Service.

Mr. Zalucky spent most of his career overseas, devising solutions to political and cultural challenges, and engaging foreign government officials on regional stability issues. He is a Central and Eastern Europe expert and has experience in South Asia and the Middle East. In 1997-1999 and 2003-2005 in Washington, Mr. Zalucky served in Senior Executive positions, working with White House officials on issues which affected policy on specific projects.

Presently, Paul serves as Managing Director of ENKI Consulting, LLC, an independent, international business intelligence and risk consultancy offering premium, customized services. He divides his time between the USA and Europe, focusing on business in Central and Eastern Europe. With an office and close network of government, business, and academic contacts in the region, Mr. Zalucky helps companies and organizations research into opportunities and assess risks for projects dealing with infrastructure, security and defense, cybersecurity and finance.

Mr. Zalucky was co-chair of the Defense and Security Committee at the American Chamber of Commerce, Warsaw, Poland, and has served as guest lecturer at Warsaw University and the George C. Marshall European Center for Security Studies in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Germany.

Paul has also worked with the U.S. Special Operations Community and been involved with military veterans on PTSD and CTE issues.

Mr. Zalucky is a member of the U.S.-Ukraine Business Council and an active member of the Ukrainian diaspora communities in the U.S. and Canada.

He holds a B.A. in Political Science from Northwestern University, a Master's Degree in International Affairs from Georgetown University, and is fluent in Ukrainian, Polish, and Russian.
