



## **Adam Bergmann**

Adam is an expert in international relations with the deep expertise and experience in project management, diplomacy, new market development, multicultural team building, government relations, corporate leadership, major contract delivery, crisis management, and cultural fluency.

Born in the USA, originally from New York City, he has been professionally engaged in Central and Eastern Europe for +25 years working for global corporations, government, think-tanks, and as independent consultant and entrepreneur.

Mr. Bergmann is also the Managing Director of Bergmann & Associates providing corporate intelligence and investigations, security assessments, risk mitigation and trade advisory services.

As the co-founder and managing director of PricewaterhouseCoopers' (PwC) Aerospace, Defense and Security (ADS) advisory practice, he served as financial advisor to the Polish Government on the largest aerospace sector transaction in Central Europe in 2009, and on the restructuring of the largest Polish defense sector company.

Mr. Bergmann was the director of the Polish F-16 office for Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Company. As the senior expatriate representative leading the office he was directly involved in the largest defense product sale in Central & Eastern Europe (\$3.5 B) – the procurement of 48 F-16 aircraft by the Government of Poland. He managed key projects within the world's largest Offset program (\$6.028 B) associated with the countertrade requirements for the F-16 program.

Mr. Bergmann was the Founder and first Executive Director of the Canadian-Polish Chamber of Commerce.

In his role as the Regional Manager for Alcatel Transportation Canada, Mr. Bergmann coordinated Alcatel Transportation's contacts and presence in Central and Eastern Europe while working with the key decision-makers in local and national governments.

Adam served as a Commercial Officer at the Canadian Embassy in Warsaw, proactively developing trade and investment, helping businesses succeed in Poland.

Educated in Canada, Poland and the UK, he holds a M.Sc. from the London School of Economics specializing in Political and Economic Transformation of Central & East European countries, and a B.A. from University of Guelph (Canada) in International Relations / Political Science.

Mr. Bergmann is active in local charity and service organizations. He is a Past-President of Rotary Club Warsaw-Wilanów and is a Major Donor to Rotary International.
